PEDAGOGICAL ACTIVITIES TOOLKIT FOR STUDENTS

- The Ministry of Education (MEES) will continue providing activities for students on the ecoleouverte.ca website.
- Pedagogical activities continue to be added to the SWLSB Learning Backpack on our website.
- In addition to the pedagogical activities from the MEES, our teachers may customize and/or create their own activities. The MEES mentioned that activities are not to be corrected or used for marking purposes.

As per MEES directives, the objective of these activities is to consolidate and maintain the learning acquired up until the school and centre closure. Although these pedagogical activities remain optional for students, teachers will be communicating with students on a weekly basis to provide pedagogical support.

For our Adult Education students, resources are available here. We are awaiting more details regarding resources for Vocational Training students. These should be provided shortly.

School teams may also be sending additional information to their school/centre communities relating to student services, guidance, CEGEP applications, etc.
