Commissioner James Di Sano MOVED THAT, on the recommendation of the Director of Material Resources and Transportation, the Executive Committee of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board approve the order placed with Visa-Vie Inc. in the amount of \$96,250.00, before taxes, or \$102,878.50, net taxes;

AND THAT the Chairperson or, in their absence or with their knowledge, the Vice-Chair as well as the Director General or, in their absence or with their knowledge, the Assistant Director General be authorized to sign all documentation concerning this acquisition.

4.0 QESBA:

4.1 Special Assessment – Court Challenge on Bill 40:

The Chairperson thanked Commissioner Guy Gagnon for his input on the resolutions concerning the court challenge and the progressive entry for the 2020-2021 school year.

Special Assessment – Court Challenge on Bill 40 WHEREAS the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board believes that Bill 40 denies our constitutional right granted in Section 23 of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms granting an exclusive power of management and control over minority language instruction and facilities to rightsholders or their representative;

WHEREAS the Council of Commissioners of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board adopted resolution no. CC-200527-CA-0111, expressing its full support for the Quebec English School Boards Association (QESBA) and its co-applicants' challenge to Bill 40's constitutionality;

WHEREAS the declaration of intervention of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board to become a coapplicant in the court challenge was authorized;

WHEREAS the applicants were granted the initial challenge for a stay on the applications of Bill 40;

WHEREAS the Government of Québec has taken the decision to challenge and appeal this ruling;

WHEREAS this appeal by the Government of Québec will incur additional legal costs for the QESBA that may exceed the initial budget set aside for this purpose;

WHEREAS the QESBA is proposing a special assessment of \$2.00 per student for all its English School board members to help offset its growing legal fees;

WHEREAS the QESBA is also exploring other avenues of funding to further finance the legal challenges;

Commissioner Guy Gagnon MOVED THAT the Executive Committee of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board approve the request of the Quebec English School Boards Association for a special assessment fee of \$2.00 per student for the 2020-2021 school year.

5.0 Financial Resources:

5.1 Allocation of Measure 15028:

In response to a question from Commissioner Guy Gagnon, the Director of Financial Resources noted that Measure 15028 was new in 2019-2020 and is for extracurricular activities for the high schools. These activities are outside of regular school hours.

WHEREAS appendix 1, section 1.1 of by-law no. BL2008-CA-01: Delegation of Functions & Powers of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board authorizes the Executive Committee to "Exercise all functions and powers of the Council of Commissioners during the period from July to the date of the August meeting of the Council of Commissioners";

WHEREAS the Council of Commissioners of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board adopted resolution no. CC-200429-FR-0090, accepting the recommendations of the Resource Allocation Committee for the 2020-2021 school year, which includes Measure 15028: Extracurricular Activities for High Schools, as a protected measure;

WHEREAS the Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur (MEES) has modified Measure 15028, changing it from a protected measure to a dedicated measure;

WHEREAS said measure is to be allocated upon request, as indicated in the Allocation of Resources 2020-2021 document adopted by resolution no. CC-200429-FR-0090;

WHEREAS the high schools were consulted on their individual needs;

WHEREAS the Resource Allocation Committee held a special meeting on August 14, 2020;

WHEREAS it is recommended by the Resource Allocation Committee to allocate all funds as individually requested by all high schools and to distribute any remaining balance of Measure 15028 on a per capita basis;

Commissioner Bob Pellerin MOVED THAT, on the recommendation of the Resource Allocation Committee, the Council of Commissioners approve the allocation of funds from Measure 15028 to the high schools as recommended by the Resource Allocation Committee, and as more precisely detailed below:

WHEREAS the Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur (MEES) has mandated that all students physically return to school for the 2020-2021 school year;

WHEREAS appendix 1, section 1.1 of by-law no. BL2008-CA-01: Delegation of Functions & Powers of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board authorizes the Executive Committee to "Exercise all functions and powers of the Council of Commissioners during the period from July to the date of the August meeting of the Council of Commissioners";

WHEREAS the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board continues to affirm its constitutional right granted in Section 23 of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms granting an exclusive power of management and control over minority language instruction and facilities to rightsholders or their representative;

WHEREAS the members of the Council of Commissioners of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board have been duly and legally elected by their communities as the representatives and governing body of our school board;

WHEREAS the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board has the responsibility, first and foremost, to ensure the health and safety of all students and staff;

WHEREAS the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board's 3rd orientation in its commitment to success plan states our intention of "Promoting learning and working environments that promote health, safety and well-being";

WHEREAS several schools have made a request for progressive entry to school for 2020-2021 to allow a well organized and controlled beginning to the school year ensuring the health and safety of all their students and staff;

WHEREAS progressive entry was given as a viable option by the MEES as part of the of the reopening of schools on May 11, 2020, following the emergency closing of schools due to COVID-19;

WHEREAS a progressive entry would allow to gradually reintegrate schools and buildings without overwhelming both students, teachers and staff and allow for verification of measure put in place to mitigate the spread of COVID-19;

Commissioner Vicky Kaliotzakis MOVED THAT, on the recommendation of the Director General, the Executive Committee of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board approve the request for progressive entry for all its schools over a period of not more than three (3) days, as of the students' first day of school.

Carried unanimously

The Chairperson requested that this resolution be sent to QESBA so that it can be shared with its other member school boards.

7.0 Adjournment:

The Director General thanked the entire Council for its unwavering support in this time of uncertainty noting that when administrators were advised on Monday that a resolution would be presented today for progressive entry the level of anxiety diminished greatly.

The Chairperson noted that the Council has a high level of respect for the students and staff and that the Council hopes that its current term can be extended so that it can continue to work for the success of the students of this school board.

Parent Commissioner Stéphane Henley MOVED the adjournment of the meeting.
