Dear Parents/Guardians,

We all have an important role to play to limit the transmission of COVID-19. It is crucial that everyone respects and models directives received from public health and that our students also respect the directives given by their schools and centres.

Wearing of Mask

INDOOR SPACES & TRANSPORTATION

All students, from grades 5 and up, **must wear a mask** during <u>transportation</u> to and from school as well as in <u>common areas</u> outside the classroom. Although the wearing of the mask is not compulsory for the other grade levels, it is strongly recommended.

OUTDOORS

Masks are **not required** if students remain within their **stable group** or if they can **maintain physical distancing**.

CONSEQUENCES

Schools and centres will be firm in ensuring that these directives are respected at all times. Therefore, students who do not respect the public health directives and measures implemented, will have consequences which may lead to (but not limited to):

- loss of privileges
- loss of transportation services
- immediate suspension

The purpose of these directives is to protect the health of all students and staff and it is our obligation, as a school board, to make sure they are respected at all times.

We thank you for modeling, practicing and reinforcing proper hygiene habits (hand washing, physical distancing, coughing in elbow, wearing of face covering or mask) with your child. Your role as a parent is crucial and helps reinforce the message conveyed at school as one common message for our student population.

Virtual Campus (strictly for exempted students)

We are pleased to announce that the SWLSB will have a virtual campus **strictly reserved for students** who have been **exempted to be at school by a physician** and **approved by our Pedagogical Services**. The Virtual Campus will be in operation as of the week of September 14th. To date, we have over 100 students enrolled. Parents of exempted students received by email, all the required information.
