4.0 Engagement of Contractor – Removal of Asbestos – Souvenir ES

The Director of Material Resources and Transportation advised that the basement at Souvenir Elementary School is being renovated in order to accommodate the new Pre-Kindergarten and existing Kindergarten classes for the 2019-2020 school year. There is asbestos and it needs to be removed so that the project can move forward. The cost for the removal was higher than expected but it should be covered within the project budget.

The Chairperson noted that due to the urgency of this project a decision had to be taken prior to the June 26, 2019 meeting of the Executive Committee so its functions and powers were withdrawn and then reinstated because the cost of this renovation project falls within the scope of its delegations.

Removal of Asbestos Souvenir ES WHEREAS the Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur (MEES) announced that beginning in the 2019-2020 school year a Pre-Kindergarten program would be implemented throughout Québec for schools that are rated 6, 7, 8, 9 or 10 on the socio-economic scale;

WHEREAS Souvenir Elementary School will have Pre-Kindergarten classes in the 2019-2020 school year;

WHEREAS renovations are required at the school in order to accommodate these Pre-Kindergarten classes;

WHEREAS renovations at the school have begun and asbestos has been found and needs to be removed:

WHEREAS, due to the urgency of the need to remove the asbestos, an invitational tender was called for the removal of asbestos and subsequently opened on May 28, 2019;

WHEREAS only one bid was received and is conformable;

Commissioner James Di Sano MOVED THAT, on the recommendation of the Director of Material Resources and Transportation, the Council of Commissioners of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board award the contract for the removal of asbestos at Souvenir Elementary School to Roland Grenier Construction for a total cost of 87 750,00\$ before taxes, 100 890,56\$ all taxes included or 93 793,12\$ net taxes;

AND THAT the Chairperson, or in their absence or with their knowledge the Vice-Chairperson, as well as the Director General, or in their absence or with their knowledge the Assistant Director General, be authorized to sign all documentation concerning this project;

FURTHER THAT, the Director of Material Resources and Transportation, be authorized to sign documentation concerning this project, as per By-Law no BL2008-CA-01: Delegation of Functions & Powers of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board.
